- A new motor has been ordered for the treatment plant.

- There were about 10 frozen lines reported. It is recommended that customers get a letter from a certified plumber stating where the problem is located.

- The Drought Watch was upgraded to a Drought WARNING.

- Annual water summary report. Supply vs consumption. 2025 numbers got worse than 2024. Motion to approve the annual water summary report made by Tommy second by George, all in favor.
