- In a conversation with the electrical contractor about a coupling being made and a possible mis alignment.
- A line location company has been contacted. The rate of \$2800.00 per day. Motion to accept by Tommy second by George, with a 5-0 vote in favor with a second day option if needed.
- Phone calls to customers helped with shut offs.
- Four new houses going up in Lake Hauto on the Carbon side.


- Set up a meeting with Lansford borough about turning water on at the pool concession stand.
