New Business

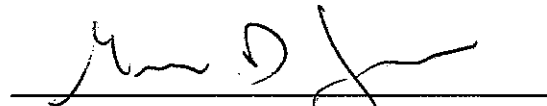
- We agreed to take pictures of the wall at the mid rise.
